The following is the process for reapplying for the position of “Civilian Recruit in Training”.

1. Applicants who do not successfully complete the testing process (LEAB test, Oral Boards, PAT) must wait thirty (30) days from the test date before being eligible to re-apply.
2. Applicants who are successful in passing the LEAB test will move onto the Oral Boards. If the applicant does not pass the LEAB test, the applicant must wait thirty (30) days from the test date before being eligible to re-apply.
3. Applicants who are successful in passing the Oral Boards will move onto the PAT exam (Fitness Exam). If the applicant does not pass the Oral Boards, the applicant must wait thirty (30) days from the test date to re-apply.
4. Applicants who do not successfully pass the PAT (Fitness test) must wait thirty (30) days from the test date to re-apply.
5. Applicants who were successful in completing all three (3) phases of the testing process (LEAB test, Oral Board, PAT) but were not approved for placement on the Department’s Eligibility List must wait one (1) year from the date they originally applied.
6. Applicants who were approved for placement on the Department’s Eligibility List will remain on the list for eighteen (18) months and may be selected to enter the Academy at any time that a class is formed. If not selected after eighteen (18) months they will be contacted by Human Resources to determine if the applicant would like to remain on the eligibility list for eighteen (18) more months. If not selected after the second eighteen (18) months, applicant must re-apply.
7. The Human Resources Division strives to complete the entire selection process within three (3) months from the date of receiving the initial testing results.
