Police Seek Help Identifying Suspect in Attempt Bank Robbery

The Metropolitan Police Department, City of St. Louis (“the department”) is seeking assistance from the public in identifying an individual believed to be responsible for an attempt bank robbery that occurred January 28, 2013 at Bank of America located at 2604 S. Jefferson.

On January 28 at 4:20 p.m. the suspect entered the bank, approached the bank teller and showed a note demanding cash. The suspect never displayed a weapon nor did he indicate that he had a weapon. The suspect fled the bank on foot before any cash was handed over to him.

The suspect is described as a black male, 35-40 years old, approximately 5’10” to 6’0” tall, weighing between 180-210lbs. At the time of the robbery, the suspect was wearing a blue stocking cap and blue fleece jacket.
