SLMPD to Implement Neighborhood Ownership Model In Baden Neighborhood

On October 9, 2013, the Metropolitan Police Department, City of St. Louis (“the department”) Problem Property and Neighborhood Liaison Officers will inform residents of the Baden neighborhood about the Neighborhood Ownership Model, a program that assists citizens in developing and implementing a safety plan in their neighborhood, as well as invite them to an upcoming meeting. City services will also be implemented to secure vacant buildings, clean streets and alleys and make necessary repairs.

Roll call for the participating officers will be held at the intersection of Broadway and Gimblin. The objective of this initiative is to build relationships with the community we serve and ask citizens to become involved in the Neighborhood Ownership Model in order to deter and combat crime in their neighborhood.
