Metropolitan Police Department, City of St. Louis CALEA® On-Site Assessment

The Metropolitan Police Department, City of St. Louis (“the department”) will undergo an on-site assessment as part of a program to retain its international accreditation by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA®).

The CALEA® accreditation program requires agencies to comply with 446 state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations and support services. Accreditation is for three years, during which the agency must submit annual reports attesting continued compliance under those standards under which it was initially accredited. The CALEA® on-site Assessment Team will be comprised of public safety practitioners from out-of-state agencies.

As part of the on-site assessment, department employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments to the CALEA® Assessment Team. Comments must address the department’s ability to comply with CALEA® standards. The CALEA® standards are available for review at police headquarters, 1200 Clark Avenue. Comments will be accepted by phone, in person and in writing.
