Police Seek Help Identifying Robbery Suspect

The Metropolitan Police Department, City of St. Louis (“the department”) is requesting assistance from the public in identifying an individual responsible for a robbery that occurred on March 25 at 1:58 p.m., at the St. Louis Community Credit Union located at 4435 Chippewa. The suspect, indicating he had a weapon, demanded and received cash from a bank teller. No one was hurt.

The suspect is described as a black male, approximately 5’11”, 250 pounds and 35-40 years old. He was wearing a black coat, gray jogging pants and a black hat with the word “Kangol” and a kangaroo graphic on the front. He had a noticeable gap between his two upper front teeth. The suspect drove away in a beige vehicle, possibly an older model Dodge sedan.
