Metropolitan Officers to Receive Medal of Valor

Nine officers from the Metropolitan Police Department, City of St. Louis (“the department”) will be honored with the Crusade Against Crime’s Medal of Valor at a ceremony to be held November 17, 2011 from 12-2 p.m. at the Hilton St. Louis at the Ballpark located at 1 South Broadway. In total, 21 law enforcement officers from the St. Louis area will be recognized.

The annual event honors police officers and citizens in the St. Louis metropolitan area for conspicuous acts of bravery. Police officers are honored for acts that exceed the normal demands of police service. Police Officer Daryl Hall will be honored posthumously as will US Marshal John Perry.

The department’s 2010 Officer of the Year, Lucas Roethlisberger, will also be honored for his actions during an October 2010 incident. His partner, Officer Luke Kallal, will also be honored for the same incident.

Other honorees include: Police Officers Phillip Anderson, Marco Chrislieb, Brent Fincher, James Frost, William Helbling and Tiffany Porter.
