Police Seek Help Identifying Robbery Suspect

The Metropolitan Police Department, City of St. Louis (“the department”) is seeking assistance from the public in identifying an individual believed to be responsible for a robbery that occurred November 6, 2010, at the PNC Bank located at 4131 South Grand.

At 12:08 p.m., the suspect walked into the bank and handed a note to the teller. The suspect indicated she had a gun and that other individuals were waiting outside the bank and were also armed with guns.

The suspect is described as a black female, 45-55 years of age, approximately 5’2-5’4 and weighing approximately 140-160 pounds. She has shoulder length black hair though investigators believe it could be a wig. She was wearing all black clothing and a black and yellow hat. Police believe the suspect may be responsible for another bank robbery earlier this year.
