Police Seek Help Identifying Robbery Suspect

The Metropolitan Police Department, City of St. Louis (“the department”) is requesting assistance from the public in identifying an individual responsible for two recent robberies.

The first incident occurred on 4/15/10 at 3:16 a.m. at the Huck’s Gas Station located at 6901 Hampton. The second occurred on 4/18/10 at 11:55 p.m. at the Connoco located at 6977 Gravois. In the first incident the suspect displayed a silver gun, while in the second he indicated he had a gun but did not display one. The suspect took cash and cigarettes in both incidents. No one was hurt. He is described as a White or Hispanic Male. The suspect wore a hooded sweatshirt with a distinct design during both incidents. It can be seen in the attached surveillance photos.

Investigators believe the suspect is also involved in other incidents in St. Louis County and Arnold and are working cooperatively with the other jurisdictions.
