Police Seek Help Identifying Bank Robbery Suspect

The Metropolitan Police Department, City of St. Louis (“the department”) is requesting assistance from the public in identifying an individual believed to be responsible for a bank robbery that occurred September 9, 2011 at the Carrollton Bank located at 5807 Murdoch.

The suspect is described as a white male, 20-25 years old, approximately 6’0” tall, thin build with a goatee. The suspect was wearing sunglasses, a dark Cardinal’s baseball cap, a white tee shirt with a black long sleeve shirt underneath, dark pants and black gloves. The suspect was last seen carrying a black bag with white letters on the side. During the incident the suspect handed the teller a note that indicated he had a gun and demanded cash. The teller gave the suspect cash and the suspect left the bank. No one was hurt.
