



Yellow Zones
RESIDENT/RESTRICTED VEHICLE ACCESS

The Yellow Zone is for Soulard resident access and permit parking only from 3am Saturday, March 1 to 2am Sunday, March 2. All Soulard residences have received official Mardi Gras parking/access tags. In order to preserve this area for the use of Soulard residents on Grand Parade Day, any vehicles parked on the street in the Yellow Zone without an official Mardi Gras parking/access pass will be ticketed and towed.

Staging Area

Parade entries will stage on Broadway between Walnut and Chouteau, beginning at 8am. Full parade lineup in place by 10:00am.

Red Zone
NO VEHICLE ACCESS

All streets in the Red Zone will be closed to vehicular traffic and parking from 3am Saturday, March 1 to 2am Sunday, March 2. No unauthorized vehicles allowed in or out of this zone during this time.

Bud Light Grand Parade Route

Parade steps off at 11am from Busch Stadium (East of Ballpark Village) and proceeds through Soulard. Parade ends at Lynch St.

Parking/Getting to Soulard
